



TenjinPay Simulator – Functional components







Reference Data	To effectively carry out testing, the simulator must be equipped with essential reference data. This includes details such as Connection ID number,Participant ID,BIC,IBAN,Financial Institution (FI) name,Sender/Receiver Bank Information,Clearing System Information,SchemeID. These data points are crucial for executing both standard and exception test cases, ensuring accuracy & higher test coverage.
Response Rules	The system determines the appropriate response message type and content for each request received from the Clearing. Each test case has a corresponding response rule that dictates the message and information to be sent, ensuring accurate and consistent communication.
Test Repository	The repository contains all test cases as per the Scheme guidelines for the validation. It includes essential details such as SchemeID, TestCaseID, TestCaseName, Description, Persona, SchemeName, and Status. This structured approach ensures comprehensive tracking and management of test cases, facilitating efficient certification processes.
Test Execution	This profile consolidates all test cases selected for execution by the user at any given time. The test cases are sourced from the test repository, either according to predefined conformance configurations or based on the user's specific preferences
Reports	All the information pertaining to the test execution is being captured and provided as a report in PDF and XL format. The options provided in this Profile are View and Download.




